- 1 Sauvignon Blanc, Alta Baliza, Central Valley, Chile**
Refreshing, young wine showing a green yellow colour. The aromas are fresh with hints of grass and citrus fruit. On the palate, balanced acidity, light body and lingering finish. (1) 12.5% vol

- 2 Chardonnay, Alta Baliza, Central Valley, Chile**
Fresh and young, slightly golden with green olive hints. Sweet, tropical aromas such as banana and pineapple combine and on the palate, the wine is crisp, soft and well-balanced. (2) 12.5% vol

Rosé Wine

- 6 Pinot Grigio Rosato, Intorno, Puglia, Italy**
A light and delicate dry rosé with gentle hints of strawberry fruit and a sherbet touch. Soft, refreshing and uplifting. (2) 12% vol

- 7 Zinfandel Blush, Island Fox, Puglia, Italy**

- 8 Merlot, Alta Baliza, Central Valley, Chile**
An intense violet red colour. On the nose, aromas of mature fruits, red berries and some spiced notes. Rich in tannins with a medium body and has a mildly persistent finish. (C) 13% vol

- 9 Shiraz, Alta Baliza, Central Valley, Chile**
Juicy, ripe, black fruits and a typical Shiraz kick of spice. Medium-bodied with good balance. (C) 13% vol
